Birds and Debris was established to extract useful information from single instances of entanglement and nest incorporation of anthropogenic debris by birds, from anywhere in the world. This data will be used to raise awareness of the extent of debris in marine, freshwater and terrestrial environments, and to explore which species are most reported and where, and which types of debris are involved.
